



LEDs & Buttons Explanations




WiFi Connection

1. Ensure your smart phone is connected to your home WiFi network.
2. Scan the QR code or search the "Smart Life" APP from Google Play store or Apple Store.
3. Install the Smart Life APP and register account.
4. If this is the first time to use the Smart Life APP then tap "Register" and register your account by following the on screen instructions.



3. Open the APP and press the "+" button on the upper right corner to add the device.
4. Press "Others", then press "Connector (WiFi)" icon.
5. Press the WiFi connection button on gateway and hold until LED 2 begins to flash quickly (2 per second).
6. Select "Confirm indicator rapidly blink" on the APP and add your WiFi password when prompted.
7. Wait a moment until the connection is complete.

Trouble Shooting

WIFI hub will not connect:

If the WIFI hub will not connect using the above steps the WIFI hub can be connected in AP mode, to connect this way please follow the below steps.

1. Long press the  button so the so the green light is slowly flashing (1 per 2 seconds), if this is the first time the hub as been powered up then this will be the default mode, this mode can also be accessed by switching the hub off and back on.
2. long press the  again until the green light begins to flash slightly quicker (1 per second)
3. Press the  again, the green light will flash slightly quicker (2 per second)
4. Open the APP and press the “ + ” button on the upper right corner to add the device.
5. Press “Others”, then press “Connector (WIFI)” icon.
6. At the top right of the screen tap 'Other Mode', then tap 'AP Mode'
7. Select “Confirm indicator slowly blink” on the APP and add your WIFI password when prompted.
8. Tap 'Confirm' then 'Go to Connect'
9. You will then be able to select the WIFI hub from the list of available networks, select 'SmartLife-Cb9C' the hub ID may vary but will always start with 'SmartLife'
10. Tap the SmartLife network then tap 'Connect'
11. Tap the back button on your phone
12. The APP will then scan for the WIFI hub
13. Once connected tap 'Done', the green light on the hub will go solid
14. You can now add your TRV's, for instructions on how to do this see the WIFITRV manual.

FAQ

- Q. How many smart TRV's can be controlled from the APP?
A. 12 TRV's can be connected to the APP
- Q. What is the RF distance between the HUB and the smart TRV?
A. 100 meter in open area
- Q. Why can i not control my smart TRV after i have replaced the battery?
A. If you need to change the batteries the Smart TRV may reset itself and need to be re-connected to the WIFI hub, please see the TRV manual for re-connection info.
- Q. The TRV is not responding to the APP
A. Check the batteries are OK
A. Check the WIFI hub is still connected to your home WIFI and the Internet connection is good
A. If all the above are OK you may need to reset the WIFI hub and re-connect.
